





Figure 2: CRRF Urban Development¹







Figure 5: YES GIZ






Figure 8: Transform - Professionnaliser les jeunes et les professionnels de la filière transportlogistique-portuaire

1.4. CHANGES AND CORRECTIONS

The tables below explain the differences in values reported in this report (2023 annual report) and the previous EUTF MLS report (S1 2023 report). These changes and corrections are due to (i) indicator mapping revisions (when a project activity output and the associated data has been 'remapped' from one EUTF indicator to another), (ii) multiplier revisions (that is, adjustments to the formula used by the MLS to account for double counting of outputs), (iii) data corrections provided by the IP, (iv) data corrections made by the MLS team (for example, when unusual patterns are observed in a project's historical data and the IP is unable to provide an explanation in time for the report, the data points are temporarily removed from the database), (v) a project providing historical data that was not previously reported to the MLS, (vi) newly included projects in the MLS following improved communication or data collection procedures. Particularly significant changes or corrections are further explained below or in the footnotes.

It is worth noting that the following projects reviewed all data previously reported to the MLS and made multiple corrections as a result of this process.

- CRRF DIRECT CARE (Regional), HealthPro GOAL (Sudan) and RED UBF (Uganda) made various retroactive corrections to their historical output data following a request to review their historical data.
- Greater Stability East SD FAO (Sudan) made retroactive corrections to their historical output data after undertaking a standard final review of their historical reporting, as requested by the MLS for all ending projects.

Furthermore, several projects in Sudan (e.g. EPKS GIZ, HealthPro GOAL, HealthPro AICS, Acacia – Arabic Gum Value Chain in Sudan - Support and Youth & Women WE-RISE AICS) also provided data retroactively for several of their activities undertaken in the S1 2023 period, which were not initially possible to collect (during the S1 2023 data collection period) due to the outbreak of the conflict in Sudan.

In addition, the following projects retroactively reported data for S1 2023 in S2 2023 as they were unable to submit their data on time in S1 2023, resulting in large differences between their outputs in the S1 2023 semester report and those found in the 2023 annual report.

- CRRF DIRECT Protection and Assistance (Burundi)
- DRR Amhara (Ethiopia)
- DRR EDRMC (Ethiopia)
- DRR Oromia (Ethiopia)
- DRR Sidama (Ethiopia)

Finally, the MLS team undertook a comprehensive review of all historical data in preparation for the 2023 annual report, during which a number of mapping revisions were implemented to ensure methodological consistency and harmonisation. This exercise particularly affected EUTF indicators 1.3, 1.4, 2.2 and 2.9.

















#### 1.5.8. NUMBER OF BASIC SOCIAL SERVICES DELIVERED (EUTF INDICATOR 2.2)¹


















































