
			Figure 1: Legend


Figure 4: Strength through Tolerance





Figure 19: Stability & Development Tigray Trócaire






Figure 22: Disrupting Criminal Networks CIVIPOL





Figure 23: EU-IOM JI



Figure 24: Sudan and Europe - Creative Connections




Figure 25: Resilience East SD AICS

1.5. CHANGES AND CORRECTIONS

The tables below explain the differences in values reported in this report (2022 annual report) and the previous EUTF MLS report (S1 2022 report). These changes and corrections are due to (i) indicator mapping revisions (when a project activity output and the associated data has been 'remapped' from one EUTF indicator to another), (ii) multiplier revisions (that is, adjustments to the formula used by the MLS to account for double counting of outputs), (iii) data corrections provided by the IP, (iv) data corrections made by the MLS team (for example, when unusual patterns are observed in a project's historical data and the IP is unable to provide an explanation in time for the report, the data points are temporarily removed from the database), (v) a project providing historical data that was not previously reported to the MLS, (vi) newly included projects in the MLS providing historical data retroactively and (vii) projects that have been retroactively included the MLS¹ following improved communication or data collection procedures. Particularly significant changes or corrections are further explained below or in the footnotes.

It is worth noting that the following projects reviewed all data previously reported to the MLS and made multiple corrections as a result of this process.

- EU-IOM JI (Regional) made various retroactive corrections to their historical output data after undertaking a standard final review of its historical reporting, as requested by the MLS for all ending projects.
- RESET Plus Innovation Fund (Ethiopia) made various retroactive corrections to their historical output data following a request to review the historical data reported for the project by the project's new focal points.
- Stability & Services Gambella IRC made retroactive corrections to their historical output data following concerns raised by the IP when providing feedback on the first draft of the 2022 annual monitoring report.
- Kenya-EU partnership NCTC (Kenya) made various retroactive corrections to their historical output data after undertaking a standard final review of its historical reporting, as requested by the MLS for all ending projects.
- SUPREME Livelihoods WV (Uganda) made retroactive corrections to their historical output data following concerns of overreporting raised by the IP.
- WFP, through the CRRF KE Self-Reliance project (Kenya), made various retroactive corrections to their historical output data following their request to review the historical data provided by the project due to potential discrepancies identified in the previous MLS monitoring report.

Furthermore, the following Somalia projects that had previously reported data to the MLS benefitted from new reporting procedures in S2 2022 (often involving direct contact with the IP, rather than through progress reports received via EUDs as was previously the case). This has allowed for more accurate data collection, which has also resulted in multiple corrections.





1.6.1. NUMBER OF DIRECT JOBS CREATED OR SUPPORTED (EUTF INDICATOR 1.1)1




1.6.2. NUMBER OF MSMES CREATED OR SUPPORTED (EUTF INDICATOR 1.2)




1.6.3. Number of People assisted to develop income-generating activities (IGAs) (EUTF indicator 1.3)







1.6.7. Number of social infrastructures built and/or rehabilitated (EUTF indicator 2.1 bis)




1.6.8. NUMBER OF BASIC SOCIAL SERVICES DELIVERED (EUTF INDICATOR 2.2)1



1.6.9. NUMBER OF PEOPLE RECEIVING NUTRITION ASSISTANCE (EUTF INDICATOR 2.3)




1.6.10. Number of People Receiving food Security-Related Assistance (EUTF INDICATOR 2.4)1,2











1.6.14. Number of staff from local authorities and basic service providers benefitting from capacity building to strengthen service delivery (EUTF Indicator 2.8)¹






1.6.16. Number of migrants in transit, refugees/asylum seekers and IDPs protected and/or assisted (EUTF indicator 3.2)¹





1.6.17. Number of (potential) migrants reached by information campaigns on migration (EUTF indicator 3.3)¹





1.6.18. Number of voluntary returns supported (EUTF indicator 3.4)¹



1.6.19. Number of returning migrants benefitting from post-arrival assistance (EUTF indicator 3.5)




1.6.20. Number of returning migrants benefitting from reintegration assistance (EUTF indicator 3.5 bis)¹







1.6.22. Number of individuals trained on migration management and protection (EUTF indicator 3.7)¹








1.6.25. Number of infrastructures supported to strengthen governance (EUTF indicator 4.1)







1.6.30. Number of multi-stakeholder groups and learning mechanisms formed and regularly gathering (EUTF indicator 5.1)^{1,2,3}








